Bündnis für Demokratie und Vielfalt Rheingau e. V. (Alliance for Democracy and Diversity Rheingau e. V.) founded

As a result of the correctiv investigations into a secret meeting of high-ranking AfD and CDU politicians, neo-Nazis, and entrepreneurs in November 2023 near Potsdam, a group of citizens from the Rheingau region came together in January 2024, calling themselves "Alliance for Democracy Rheingau." In an impressive speed, they organized a protest to make a statement against right-wing extremism. 3,000 participants protested together on January 26, 2024 on the Domplatz in Geisenheim - and encouraged the alliance to establish the association Alliance for Democracy and Diversity Rheingau e. V. to continue setting signs through actions and public presence. The association welcomes support and new members!
